International Rules of Competition:

1. The organizers certify that they are aware of the IBSA specific rules and commit themselves to comply fully with the rules.



2. The abbreviation – IBSA - is mandatory in the event’s name. The sanction application of events that do not have the brand IBSA in their names will not be considered.
 3. The IBSA logo must be mentioned in all official announcements every time the name of the event is said.
 4. The IBSA logo should, preferably, be part of the official logo of the event.
 5. The IBSA logo must be present in all graphic material produced, at the events’ official web site and will be part, necessarily, of the look of the game, including the uniforms of the organizing committee and referees.
 - 6. The organizers commit themselves to pay for all transportation and lodging costs:**
 - 6.1.** Of the IBSA Technical Representative for the required inspection of the competition sites prior to granting sanction
 - 6.2.** Of the IBSA Technical Delegate
 - 6.3.** Of the IBSA Classifier
 - 6.4.** Of the IBSA Referee team
 7. The organizers commit themselves:
 - 7.1.** To submit to the Secretary General:
 - ◆ The entry forms for approval before distribution to the invited countries.
 - ◆ The names of participating countries for eligibility approval.
 - ◆ All technical information related to the event such as number of athletes and countries.
 - ◆ The detailed programme of the competition.
 - 7.2.** To ensure that doping control in accordance with WADA norms will take place during the competition.
 - 7.3.** To develop evaluation procedures to assess the level of satisfaction of athletes, coaches, managers and referees.
 - 7.4.** To send the complete set of results of the competition to the General Secretariat.
 - 7.5.** To send a report to the Secretary General containing the following:
 - ◆ Number of participating countries and disciplines;
 - ◆ Data of participating delegations (number of athletes, technical staff, guides, accompanying persons, authorities);and
 - ◆ Official reports.
 8. The IBSA representative in the event, who may either be the technical delegate, a manager or someone else, shall speak at the opening and closing ceremonies.
 9. The Organizers commit to collect the:
 - ◆ IBSA Capitation fees, amounting to **25 € per athlete** for the World or Continental Events.
 - ◆ IBSA Capitation fees, amounting to **15 € per athlete** for Youth and Student Events.
 - ◆ To transfer, upon request, the entire capitation fees to the IBSA General Treasurer.
